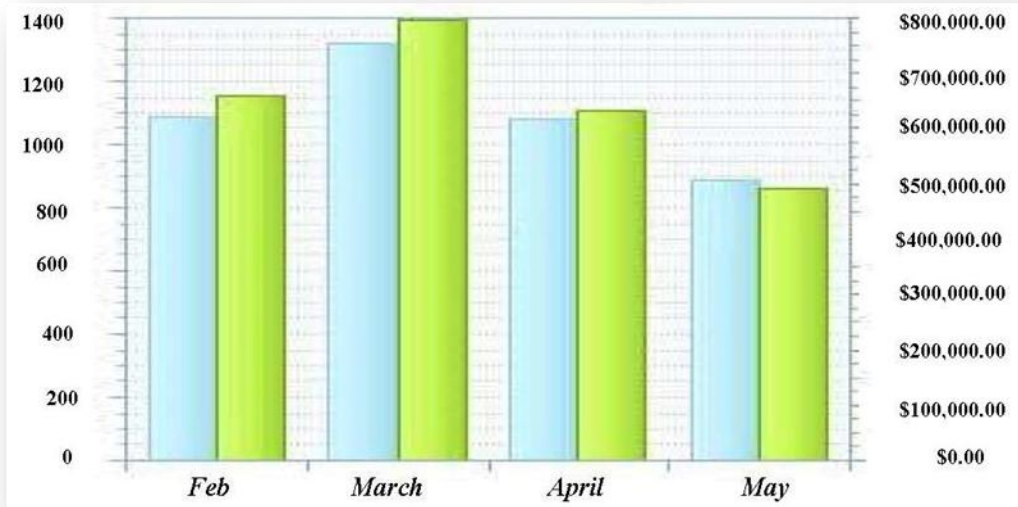


## Patient Prescription Assistance Program Report
